Keep an eye out for more information, but we will be holding a cake stall and sausage sizzle that we will require volunteer help on the day.


P & C Events

What a busy first half of the term we have had in K6O. In our writing lessons over the past few weeks, our learning intention has been to use time connectives to sequence ideas in our writing. Using the book 'Bee and Me' as a stimulus, we described a sequence of events using cohesive vocabulary to indicate order e.g. at first, next and after. This week, K6O students went along to the Multi Sports Day which was held at the Bega Indoor Sports Stadium. Students were involved in a variety of sports, modified to suit their individual needs. The activities were run by professional coaches from state sporting bodies. The day was a great success with students and staff having a fantastic time.



Class News KB

KB have been very busy this term. We had a wonderful time at the Bega Museum looking at and climbing on some of the old things. We especially liked the tractors and buggies. We have also been learning different types of breathing that will help us when we need to focus, like snake breathing, bee breathing and the grounding breath. In class we have been learning about Claude Monet and his love of painting outside. This week we did a recreation of the bridge over his waterlily pond. Class News 5/6R

We have been highly engaged in class listening to "Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes" and completing literacy based activities in this English unit. We are looking at Australia's global connections with other countries, in particular Japan. Making a paper crane is not an easy task, but the students are taking on the challenge. In Science, we have been predicting, hypothesising and completing experiments on light in groups, then drawing diagrams and writing up our results.

A highlight for our class was meeting our 1A class buddy and we look forward to continuing this relationship throughout the year! Many of our students have been involved in sporting, creative arts and musical opportunities this term.

In Maths we have been collaborating with a partner to show our problem solving strategies. We have been improving our addition and subtraction strategies when using money and learning about

budgeting.

We have started some athletics practice in fitness and are looking forward to continuing that in our sport time with field events athletics qualifications commencing this Friday (weather permitting!). Mrs Roberts will be running the high jump finals over the next few weeks, before out school athletics carnival on Friday 18th June.
